Brazos River Outfitters guides are well-seasoned, experienced and knowledgeable guides thus, ensuring a memorable and successful hunting experience.

MEALS

Our full-time chef prepares three meals a day, which are plentiful and full of variety. Special diets are prepared upon a hunter's request. Soft drinks and snacks are also supplied. We do not supply alcohol but the client can bring some for personal consumption only after all firearms are secured for the evening.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Private Ranch hunts include small personal cabins, lodge or bunk house. Brazos River Ranch has very comfortable heated cabins that are equipped with either 2 sets of bunk beds or a full size bed and one set of bunks. You will need to bring your own pillow and bedroll. If you have been successfully drawn through the state lottery system, for our National Forest hunts, you most likely will stay in very comfortable heated canvas wall tents. Each tent camp is private/exclusive in nature to one group and is set up with the amenities of comfortable cots; separate bathroom tent and a separate cook/eating tent.

TROPHY CARE

The guides will skin and cape your trophy for you. If you decide to use a different taxidermist from the one we recommend, your guide will cover up the points and skull plate in preparation for your return flight in accordance with all airplane regulations. Your cape will also be prepared for your flight or drive home. If you use the taxidermist we recommend, your guide will assist and arrange for your trophy to be transported to the taxidermist.

MEAT CARE

Your trophy will be skinned promptly, hang up and cooled before being quartered and de-boned. If your plans are to take the meat home with you by vehicle or air, you will need to provide 2 large coolers. If you forget your 2 large coolers, then we will provide at camp for purchase. If you wish to use the meat processor we recommend, we will arrange and facilitate transportation to the processor. Even though, we recommend these fine local establishments, you are responsible for contacting them on the details, making payment, shipping selection and all other details needed. Meat donations are acceptable and the proper paperwork will be provided at camp.

TRANSPORTATION DURING THE HUNT

The majority of our hunting is done by four-wheel drive vehicles and by foot. Very little horseback hunting is required simply because the terrain does not permit, especially on private land. The only time horses are used is when an area is in a wilderness setting and packing-in is a necessity.

LICENSE FEES

Drawn licenses are non-transferable and non-refundable for any reason and are obtained through the New Mexico lottery system. Private Ranch Hunts are guaranteed (no draw) but require a valid New Mexico hunting license purchased through the New Mexico Dept. of Game & Fish. Our "Hunt Agreement" will be sent with other pertinent information needed to obtain your license. Your license will be available to you at camp

TRANSPORTATION TO THE HUNTING AREA

Each hunter is responsible for his or her own transportation into camp by either flying or driving. If you elect to fly in, car rental is available at Albuquerque International Airport, Albuquerque New Mexico. Directions will be provided to hunt area for all hunters.

NEW MEXICO GROSS RECEIPT TAX

New Mexico sales tax will be included in the final price of your hunt.

GRATUITIES

We all understand that gratuities/tips are strictly at the discretion of the individual. However, our guides and chefs both work **very hard** to ensure your trip is as successful and memorable as you expect. I like to compare giving gratuities/tips to the staff to giving gratuities/tips to a restaurant waiter/waitress. The **expected** gratuities/tips for a waiter/waitress in a restaurant is 15%-20% of the cost of your total bill and all they do is serve for 30min to a hour. Our staff serves your needs for your entire stay. With that being said; Hunting guides start at \$400.00 and cooks starts at \$150.00 per client. Remember, this is only an explanation to help you make an informed decision.
